

**Greetings:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Oxford (the "Town"), in the County of Oxford, qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Oxford Elementary School, cafeteria, at 79 Pleasant Street in said Town, on January 4th, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

Article 1: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2: Shall an ordinance entitled Moratorium on Retail Marijuana Establishments and Retail Marijuana Social Clubs be enacted?

Article 3: To see if the Town will vote to amend the "Sewer Use Ordinance, Town of Oxford, Maine" Section 14.3 as follows:

**14.3 BILLINGS**


